## Sydney Aquarium Takes Stock

The annual half yearly stocktake starts early at Sydney Aquarium with over 12,000 aquatic creatures to be counted in April's Fish Census.

Every year Sydney Aquarium must conduct a head count and report to the Department of Primary Industries the number of aquatic animals they house - accounting for births, deaths (unfortunately no marriages) and any acquisitions.

Throughout the year Sydney Aquarium residents breed and new animals make it their home, so a head count is the only way to confirm the current number of residents in this unique underwater world. With such a big task at hand, this year they're calling for help.

There are 60 individual tanks and 3 huge oceanariums throughout Sydney Aquarium filled with thousands of different animals including eels, hermit crabs, sea horses, coral, jellyfish, sea urchins, numerous sea anemones, and much more.

The massive Great Barrier Reef exhibit, which is the largest of its kind in the world, holds 2.6 million litres of sea water. Plus, there is the Seal Sanctuary, touch pools and the Shark Oceanarium.

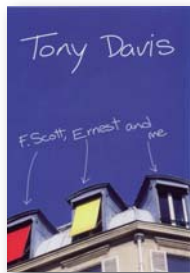
During the April school holidays Sydney Aquarium is inviting children to volunteer to help spot and record the number of grey nurse sharks, sea horses, clownfish, penguins, eels and lionfish.

The experts at Sydney Aquarium will then do a second official head count to confirm the numbers. The child who most accurately reports the population of each of the above animals will win an Aqua Club family membership – giving them unlimited entry to Sydney Aquarium for a whole year.

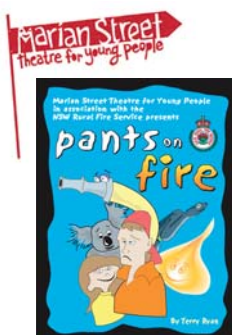
